Harold Lloyd Stancil died 70 years ago this year

Harold Lloyd Stancil, son of Eva Mercer and George Ira Stancil, saw "Wings of Gold," a Navy recruitment film made in 1938, with cousin, Glenn Stancil, son of Alvin. He told Glenn he was going to join the Navy. When he enlisted July 15, 1941, he was 17. Harold's last visit home was in 1943. He always referred to nephew Bill Batts, son of sister Vazelle, as the "Annapolis"

Kid."

"Make me a dive bomber," begged Billy.

Harold was killed aboard the USS Franklin on Oct. 13, 1944. His job was to make sure the catching cable was ready for the next plane to land. It was a U.S. Hellcat which was followed by a Japanese Torpedo Bomber. The Air Boss yelled, "Hit the deck. They are coming." The torpedo missed the ship, but the

plane hit the deck and debris killed Harold instantly. Harold was the first sailor killed on the USS Franklin. He was wrapped in an American Flag and buried at sea. His mother was sent his purple heart. A memorial to Harold is in the Stancil Cemetery.

Bill graduated in 1959 from the U.S. Naval Academy in Annapolis, Md. He retired as a Naval Commander in 1980.
